Herbert (Herb) Ervin Dickson passed away peacefully on Saturday, November 9 at Hospice House of Union County after a short illness. Herb was born October 20, 1946 in Charlotte, NC to Maurice and Mary Westmoreland Dickson, now deceased. He was a 1965 graduate of Harding High School and proudly served his country in the US Air Force from 1966 to 1970.
