Jason Edward Twombly of Waxhaw, North Carolina passed away on Sunday, February 7, 2021. He was 50 years old.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Thursday, February 11, 2021 at 1pm at St. Matthew Catholic Church with Father Peter Ascik Celebrant. Burial will be private.

Jason was born in Dover, Delaware on March 25, 1970 to James and Jean Anne Twombly.

After graduating from Spalding High School, he attended the University of Rhode Island where he graduated with a degree in Pharmacy. Jason received his Masters of Business Administration from Southern New Hampshire University. He spent his career working in the pharmacy benefit management industry, most recently as Chief Growth Officer with HRGI. Jason loved cheering on his kids from the sidelines, the Oakland Raiders, and live music.
