Jeanne graduated from UNC in 1982 and worked for Mecklenburg County as a Medicaid Caseworker for 18 years. While at UNC, Jeanne met the love of her life and they would marry in 1983 and embark on a 37 year journey of being best friends and making wonderful memories as well as supporting each other during the tough times that are sure to come in this world.

Upon retirement from Mecklenburg County in 2000, Jeanne was able to spend more time with her pride & joy, son Travis. They shared so many special times of playing games, laughing & just being silly.

Jeanne was very gifted musically, playing piano and flute. She was a member of the Charlotte Flute Choir for 44 years, joining while in the 10th grade. She loved being a part of the group & especially playing at retirement communities. The group would stay after the performance to visit and chat with the residents. Jeanne loved seeing joy on their faces from listening & singing along with the pieces & from the connection afterward.

Jeanne had an honest, transparency about her that would instantly make people feel at ease & comfortable in sharing their thoughts & feelings with her. She loved the Lord with all her heart and was so grateful for her church family at New City. She was a member of various Sunday School classes, the Moms in Prayer group, bible study groups and played in the church orchestra. Jeanne would want all member of these groups to know how grateful she was for their friendship, support and love and for helping her to grow in her walk with God.

Despite health challenges most of her life, Jeanne was an adventurous soul. She loved climbing trees as a youngster and would jump from one tall tree to the roof of her house; loved riding a neighbor's pony bareback and went hang gliding off Lookout Mountain in

Georgia. Jeanne also enjoyed snow skiing, water sports and just hanging out at the lake; it was her happy place.

Jeanne is predeceased by her parents, Charles and Emogene Standard and infant daughter Kristen Jamison. Survivors include husband Jack Jamison, son Travis Jamison, daughter-in-law Haley Ruehle Jamison, sister Nancy Jones, brother-in-law Bo Jones and many loving nephews, nieces & cousins.
